Leather

(Some pre-cut leather will be available for purchase from Mike Davis also.)

Lining leather if you want it lined.

Two 3/4" or 1" center bar buckles or buckles & keepers, & one 1/2" buckle for the throat latch.
Two 3/4" loop style Conchos for brow band or Chicago screws or string ties. **Leather Machine Co.** will provide a machine to sew your headstall.

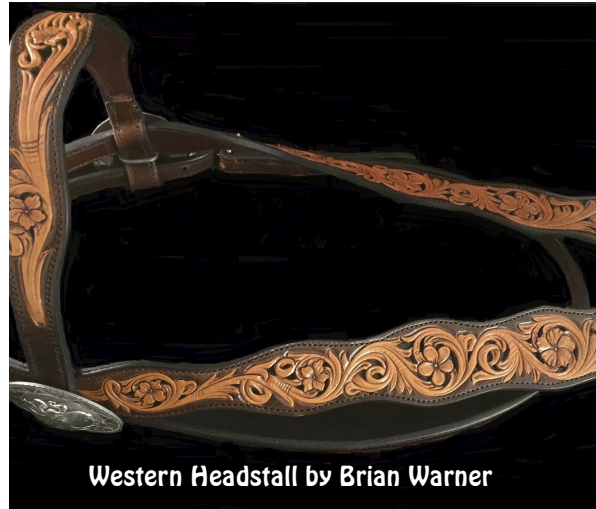
